Drawing is a way of seeing and communicating. This course is an introductory exploration of drawing, designed for those looking to develop and strengthen their personal eye and visual language. We will discover principles of observation, composition, value, and mark-making. Each session will focus on a specific technique and will include demonstrations, practice, and individual and group critique. NEW! Dynamic Figure Drawing the Natural Way (Ages 16 & up)

Are you ready to loosen up and enhance your figure drawing skills? We will be working with a live model through a series of exercises based on the classic figure drawing text, *The Natural Way to Draw*. This uninstructed session is based on exercises from the classic life drawing text by Kimon Nicolaidis. This figure drawing studio is for intermediate to advanced life drawing students and it is highly recommended that the students have had at least one figure drawing class. Starting with gesture and contour drawings, you'll train your eye and your hand to work together to capture the essence of a figure in motion or at rest. Each session will be based on a chapter of exercises and concepts from Nicolaidis' book. Later exercises will develop your ability to convey the figure's posture and attitude, as well as convincingly draw a clothed figure. This course is uninstructed.
