SCHOLARSHIPS, MINI CAMPS and DANCE INTENSIVE



Durham Arts Council awards scholarships on the basis of financial need. Scholarships are awarded through a formal application process, and DAC offers scholarships to children and teens for up to 75% of the cost of the camp. The awards are made based upon the financial need of the child/teen's family. A scholarship application should be completed and attached to the camp registration form. Scholarships for DAC School and camps are generously provided by a memorial grant in memory of Susan F. Durham has a rich history dating back to before the 1800's when it was home to the Eno and Occaneechi Native American tribes. Over time plantations were established and soon mills and large corporations began to develop. Educational institutions were also established with Durham being home to the first publically supported liberal arts college for African Americans. Durham continues to grow and is now home to the largest university-related research park and the most recognizable minor league baseball team in the nation. Learn about Durham and what makes it the unique city it has become.

Summer Dance Intensives (Ages 7-12)

Dancing Through the Ages

9am-3pm • June 11-15

This summer dance intensive camp is for beginner and intermediate level dancers that will include creative movement, improvisational exercises, intro to ballet, jazz, and contemporary in addition to dance history and choreography. At the end of the week, there will be a fully costumed performance showcasing the students' introduction to America's favorite dance crazes, including Swing Dance, Sock hop, Disco, and more.

Cirque de Danse

9am - 3pm • August 13-17, August 20-24

This summer dance intensive camp is for beginner and intermediate level dancers that will include, creative movement, improvisational exercises, intro to ballet, jazz and contemporary in addition to dance history and choreography. At the end of each week, there will be a fully costumed performance of the Cirque de Danse. Campers will also be invited to perform at Centerfest on the main dance stage during Centerfest weekend in September. The camp is designed so campers have the option of attending for one or two weeks.

TWO WEEK CULTURAL ARTS CAMPS

Your camper will take a journey across the globe during Cultural Camp. Each one or two-week session is a fun and in-depth exploration of the arts and culture of a country. Depending on age and interest, student will choose a performing or visual arts track. Each session culminates in camp exhibition and performance on the last Friday at 1:30pm.

Cultural Camps run from **9:00 AM – 3:00 PM** with early drop off beginning at 8:00 AM. DAC provides a fresh fruit snack. If your camper has food allergies to fruit, please pack a snack. Please pack your campers a brown bag lunch (no refrigerator or microwave available).

For Cultural Camps, choose your arts track based on the campers age and interest.

Age 5 & 6: Creative Kids - For Rising K and 6 year olds, this camp offers storytelling, dance, music and fun age appropriate art activities for our youngest campers.

For ages 7-13 - Choose between visual or performing arts track.

Performing Arts Track Classes include: Dance, Theater, Chorus



Session A: Swinging Swaziland

Nestled in southern Africa Swaziland is full of friendly people and ancient tradition. Home to one of Africa's largest festivals, the Umhlanga Festival, you can see some of the music, dance and poetry that is weaved throughout the culture. Many types of traditional arts and crafts are created there including batik, glass and weaving. With its diverse landscape, including parks, reserves and sanctuaries, over 700 species of animals can be found roaming the country. Come explore this vibrant African nation!

Session B: Captivating Cabaret

With the French Revolution behind them and changes from the Industrial Revolution shaping the country, the stage was set in France for a major movement in art. It was a period of joy and hope. Cabaret, as we know it, was born so artists could share ideas and Le Chat Noir and Moulin Rouge opened as artistic escapes for the French people. Visual artists left behind cluttered historical styles and modernized their designs. With influences from the British Arts and Craft movement and Japanese wood-block prints mixing with a newfound reverence of nature; Art Nouveau was born. Take a step back in time to see what this exciting lifestyle was like!

Session C: Significant Sri Lanka

Sri Lanka - with over 2,000 years of history - is home to an array of incredible architecture and artifacts, largely inspired by its rich spiritual culture. Though Buddhism and Indian culture have heavily influenced the arts, each kingdom had its own artistic voice making the arts in this country distinctive. Masks are one craft you will see throughout history in this country since they were not only used for ritual and dramas, but to cure sickness. Come discover the secrets of this island nation!

Session D: Groovy Guyana

Rice Fields, Sugar Plantations and craft markets with brightly colored textiles, paintings and baskets can be found throughout the country. Come learn about this groovy South American Country!

TEEN INTENSIVES AND CAREER CONNECTIONS

Each 1 week intensive is designed for middle/high school teens (ages 13-17, unless otherwise noted) that have some experience with art and want to learn more about a media in depth. Each class focuses on a particular artistic area, allowing for teens to develop works that can be included in their portfolio and explore career opportunities by meeting local artists and professionals. All classes take place at the Durham Arts Council. **Each 1 week intensive is \$115.** If you bundle a morning and afternoon intensive for a full day the cost is \$210.

Jam Session

Jam Session is a week-long camp in which you will have the opportunity to engage with other musicians in an organized setting while learning to play songs as a band. Led by Durham music scene veteran Stephen Coffman (of The Beast) you work on songs from the Rock, Funk and Pop canon, as well as anything else that you are interested in playing! Students are expected to bring their own equipment and have at least 1 year of experience on his or her instrument. Basic ability to read music is encouraged, but not mandatory. (Ages 12 and up.)


Mixed Media Abstractions

SUMMER, INTERSESSION AND TEACHER WORKDAY ARTS CAMP REFUND POLICY: Parents who need to withdraw their child/children from any Summer or Intersession Arts Camp, for any reason should contact DAC Education Office in writing at least *2 weeks* before session begins. You will receive a refund, less \$30 service charge per two-week camp per session per participant and \$15 service charge per mini-camp session per participant. These are the only circumstances in which DAC gives refunds. DAC will transfer your child to a later session only if space is available. Parents who need to withdraw their child/children from any Summer or Intersession Arts Camp, for any reason, less than two weeks prior to the start date or after camp has begun should contact DAC Education Office in writing. You will not receive a refund. You may transfer your remaining balance to another camp or course in the same term for any family member. DAC will transfer your child to a later session only if space is available. Mail-in Registrations will be recorded by date of receipt. *You may mail-in, drop-off or fax (919)560.2725 registrations. CAMP LATE POLICY: Participants that are picked up after the closing time of camp will be charged a late fee. The fee is as follows: For participants who are registered until 3pm, a \$5 fee will be charged per family if participant(s) have not been picked up by 3:15pm, a \$17 fee will be charged per participant who remains after 3:30pm since the camper will at that point be participating in the Afternoon Adventures program, by default. For participants who are registered until 5:30pm, once the parent/guardian is up to 15 minutes late a \$5 fee will be charged per family. Payment is due at the time of late pick-up.
