# Triangle Youth Ballet Creative Movement

**Our Stage One Classes** are an introduction to dance through a ballet-based creative movement for boys and girls. Using music, movement and make-believe, students develop their dance skills. Young dancers experiment with new ways to move their bodies, both directed and free-form, with attention to musicality and rhythm. Age-appropriate cognitive skills, such as counting, sequential organization, spatial awareness and comparative abstract concepts are woven into the class structure.



**GRACE YEYEDU** is native of Chapel Hill, Grace trained under Lauren Lorentz de Haas and Christine Cervino Grider of the Triangle Youth Ballet. There she had the opportunity to dance various roles in ballets such as *The Sleeping Beauty*, *Giselle*, and *The Nutcracker*. As a member of the Performing Company, she attended dance festivals at UNCSA and RDA/SERBA, performing in works including Kate Currin's "Barefoot Tango" and Christine Cervino Grider's "Bubble Gum". In 2016, Grace graduated from Georgetown University with a BA in Government and currently enjoys teaching children's ballet classes.
