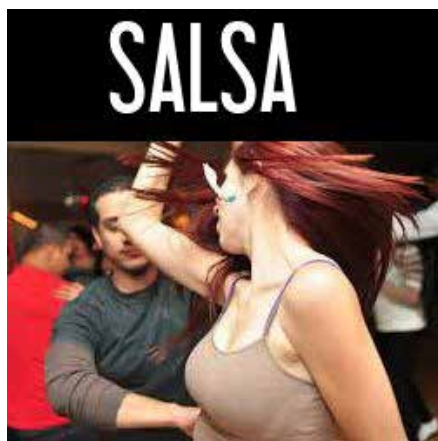

The Dancer's Workout®- Back to Basics

The Dancer's Workout® (TDW) is a high-energy adult dance fitness class which uses ballet, jazz, contemporary, pop, hip-hop, and toning exercises to deliver an exhilarating dancer's workout. These intermediate/advanced classes are taught throughout the Triangle and they move very quickly through choreography and assume dancers have solid training in ballet. Once a month, however, Jules slows it down and breaks it down in "The Dancer's Workout® - Back to Basics" workshops. These workshops are excellent for former dancers who want to start dancing again, for current TDW dancers who want to improve their dance technique, and for experienced dancers interested in the TDW Instructor Certification Program. The Dancer's Workout® - Back to Basics workshop includes warm-up, stretching, and a thorough dance cardio workout, with special emphasis on proper dance technique needed to execute the moves like a pro. Our Stage One Ballet Classes are an introduction to dance through a ballet-based creative movement for boys and girls. Using music, movement and make-believe, students develop their dance skills. Young dancers experiment with new ways to move their bodies, both directed and free-form, with attention to musicality and rhythm. Age-appropriate cognitive skills, such as counting, sequential organization, spatial awareness and comparative abstract concepts are woven into the class structure.

GRACE YEYEDU is native of Chapel Hill, Grace trained under Lauren Lorentz de Haas and Christine Cervino Grider of the Triangle Youth Ballet. There she had the opportunity to dance various roles in ballets such as *The Sleeping Beauty*, *Giselle*, and *The Nutcracker*. As a member of the Performing Company, she attended dance festivals at UNCSCA and RDA/SERBA, performing in works including Kate Currin's "Barefoot Tango" and Christine Cervino Grider's "Bubble Gum". Grace participated in Ballet Magnificat!'s summer dance intensive in Jackson, Mississippi for four years and was selected for a solo role in the student dance concert the final year. In 2016, Grace graduated from Georgetown University with a BA in Government and currently enjoys teaching children's ballet classes.

Clay Workshop

The Girl Scout Clay Workshop will allow all participants to earn their pottery badge. Participants will visit the DAC Clay studio for two sessions.
