Scholarship Information

Durham Arts Council awards scholarships on the basis of financial need. Scholarships are awarded through a formal application process, and DAC offers scholarships to children and teens for up to 75% of the cost of the course or camp. The awards are made based upon the financial need of the child/teen's family. A scholarship application should be completed and attached to the camp/class registration form. ONE WEEK MINI CAMPS

Mini Camps are designed to fill the time right after and right before the start of school for year-round and traditional school year students. Students are divided into age appropriate groups and participate in both visual and performing arts activities that are inspired by a weekly theme. **DAC provides a fresh fruit snack. If your camper has food allergies to fruit, please pack a snack. Please pack your campers a brown bag lunch (no refrigerator available).**

Mini Camp 1: Art and Story

June 14 – 18

Many artists use stories as inspiration for their art. Whether the story is one that has been passed-down through the ages, or a story from your imagination, there are all types of things you can create from a story! This camp will explore the art of performing stories, combining images and words, and creating book forms that can be a work of art in themselves.

Weekly: \$130 (\$120 per additional sibling)

Daily: \$30

Mini Camp 2: Art and Science

August 16 – 20

Did you ever wonder how they make red so red? What did they do before the paint tube (they used a pigs bladder!)? How has the camera changed the arts? What about the ipod? Artists, like scientists, have lots of questions. Explore the sciences through the arts by conducting creative experiments like making your own paint, creating music inspired by patterns in nature, and much more!

Weekly: \$130 (\$120 per additional sibling)

Daily: \$30

Need full day care? Add the Afternoon Adventures program!

Afternoon adventures complement activities campers have worked on during the day, and includes visits by extra special artists and performers as well as fieldtrips to fun cultural destinations.

TWO WEEK CULTURAL ARTS CAMPS
June 21 - August 13

Your camper will take a journey across the globe during Cultural Camp. Each two-week session is a fun and in-depth exploration of the arts and culture of a country. Depending on age and interest, student will choose a performing or visual arts track. Each two week session culminates in camp exhibition and performance on the last Friday at 12:30pm.

Cultural Camps run from 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM with early drop off beginning at 8:00 AM. DAC provides a fresh fruit snack. If your camper has food allergies to fruit, please pack a snack. Please pack your campers a brown bag lunch (no refrigerator available).

For Cultural Camps, choose your arts track based on the campers age and interest.

Age 5 & 6: Creative Kids - For Rising K and 6 year olds, this camp offers storytelling, dance, music and fun age appropriate art activities for our youngest campers.

For ages 7/8, 9/10 & 11/12 - Choose between visual or performing arts track.

Visual Track Classes include: Painting, Clay, Mixed Media/Digital Arts

Performing Arts Track Classes include: Dance, Theater, Chorus

Session A: Terrific Turkey!

Did you know that the country of Turkey, is one of the oldest continuously inhabited regions in the world! Turkey is known for the arts of calligraphy, marbled paper, embroidery and instruments with names like Baglama (a string instrument) and Saz (a long neck lute). So join our camel caravan and take a ride through this fascinating country!

You will receive a refund, less \$30 service charge per two-week camp per session and \$10 per mini-camp session. These are the only circumstances in which DAC gives cash refunds.
