**Girls 5 and older:** Black leotard, pink tights and pink ballet shoes.

**All boys:** White t-shirt, shorts or sweat pants, white socks and black ballet shoes.

**Our Stage One Ballet Classes** are an introduction to dance through a ballet-based creative movement for boys and girls. Using music, movement and make-believe, students develop their dance skills. Young dancers experiment with new ways to move their bodies, both directed and free-form, with attention to musicality and rhythm. Age-appropriate cognitive skills, such as counting, sequential organization, spatial awareness and comparative abstract concepts are woven into the class structure.

**ALEXANDRA GOEN** was born in St. Louis and began her studies at Alexandra Ballet under the artistic leadership of Alexandra Zaharias. While at Alexandra Ballet Alexandra Goen danced in many productions, most notably as the Sugar Plum in The Nutcracker, a soloist in Paquita, and a Fouette Girl in Graduation Ball. She continued her studies at Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet under the leadership of Marcia Dale Weary and had the opportunity to dance in Carnival of the Animals by Laszlo Berdo and Waltz de Joie by Melinda Howe. Alexandra Goen has attended summer programs at American Ballet Theater and at Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet.
