Guest Artist Workshop

Natural Fiber/Natural Colors (Ages 16 & up)

This two-day workshop will explore papermaking and pulp painting from plants. We'll take three plant fibers from start to finish; snow-retted flax from Canada, banana stalk (the same family as abaca) and Japanese kozo. Students will learn how fibers were processed and naturally dyed. We will screen pour and pull sheets of paper, explore composition and layout, embed botanicals into paper (bring your own flowers and found objects), pulp paint, and do final preservation on work we make. A \$50 materials fee is due to the instructor at workshop. Please check the DAC website for suggested additional supply list. There will be a 30 minute lunch break.

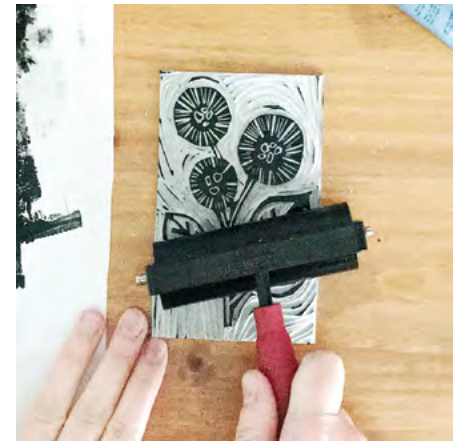

Relief Printmaking with Linocut (Ages 16 & up)

Open to all levels, participants will learn about relief printmaking: the printing process, techniques, and use of color and turn their own drawings into relief prints. Students will learn how to transfer their drawings onto linoleum blocks and carve them into the blocks using linocut tools. From there they will print an edition of prints by hand.
